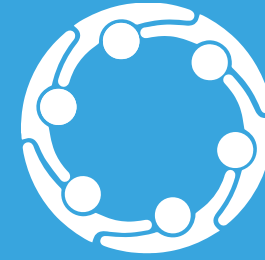

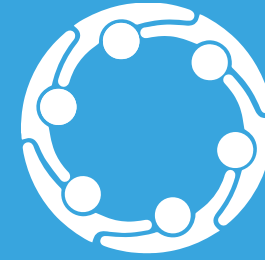

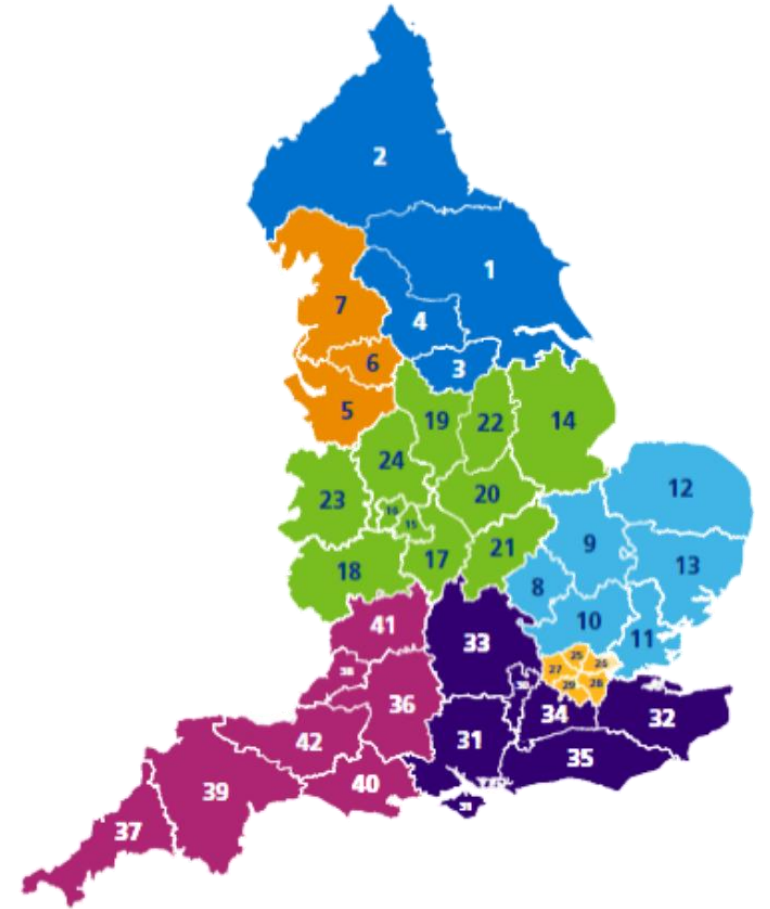

A changing landscape

42 partnerships of health and care organisations in England.



They have four aims:

1. Improve outcomes in population health and healthcare
2. Tackle inequalities in outcomes, experience and access
3. Enhance productivity and value for money
4. Help the NHS support social and economic development.

Our journey to integrated care

2016

In 2016, health and care systems came together as Sustainability & Transformation Partnerships (STPs).

ICSs as the main mechanism for delivering integrated care and place-based systems were defining features of the national NHS Long Term Plan which was published on 7 January 2019.

ICSs have developed from STPs and are driving integration at scale and pace.

Today

ICSs to be established on a statutory basis across England from 1 July 2022, bringing partners together to further support the integration of health and care.

Place-Based Partnerships



23 Primary Care Networks (PCNs) will operate across the healthcare system, and will be aligned with the four Place Based Partnerships.

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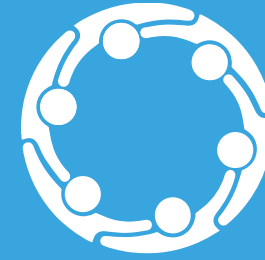
Why we need to change



Large disparities in life expectancy exist across our ICS. Males in Nottingham City can expect to **live 6.6 years less** than males in Rushcliffe.

Significant inequalities in outcomes are faced by our minority ethnic groups. Women from BAME backgrounds are significantly more likely to die during childbirth than white women.

Our system faces a significant challenge with smoking. Mansfield has the **4th worst smoking rates** in England. Smoking in pregnancy rates in parts are much higher than average.

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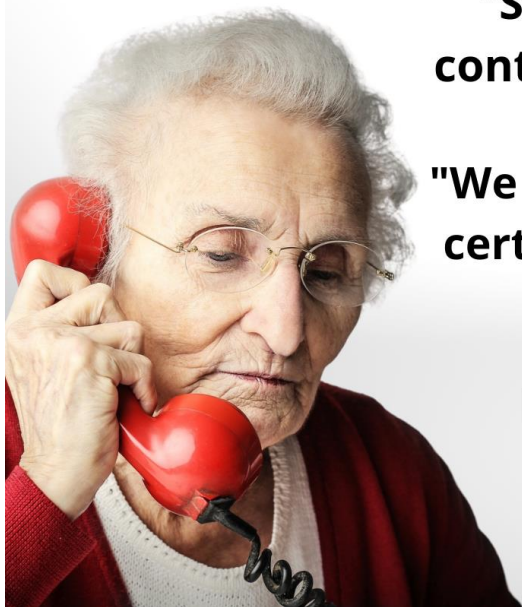

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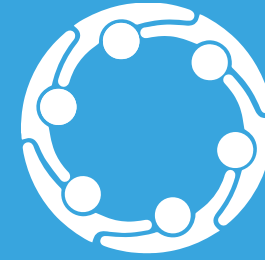

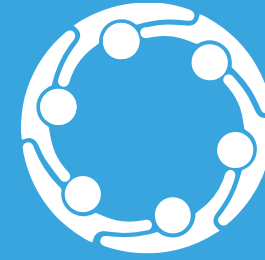

...and living with illness and disability longer

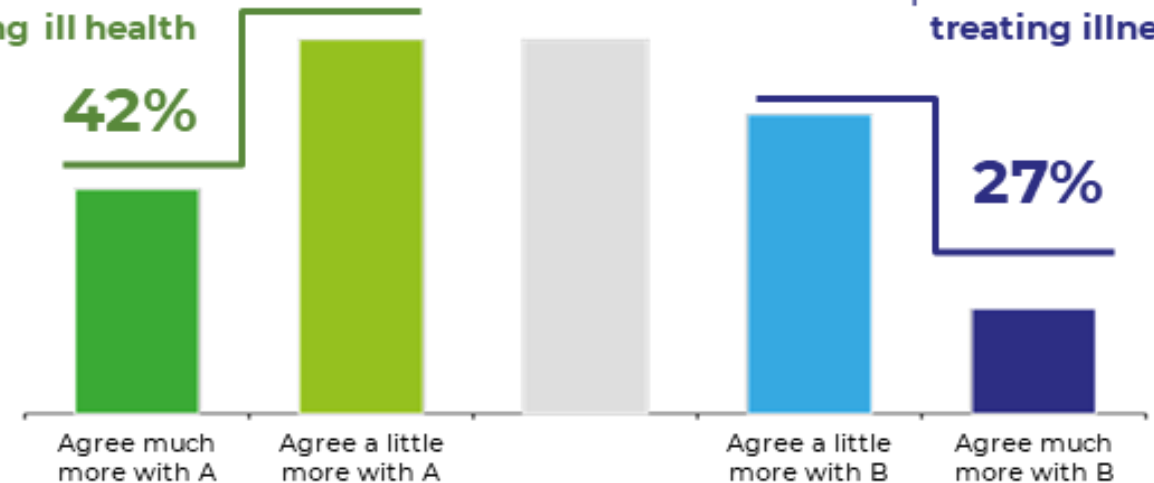
Our system has a significant challenge with deprivation...

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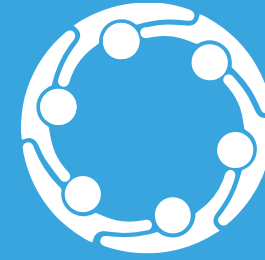
