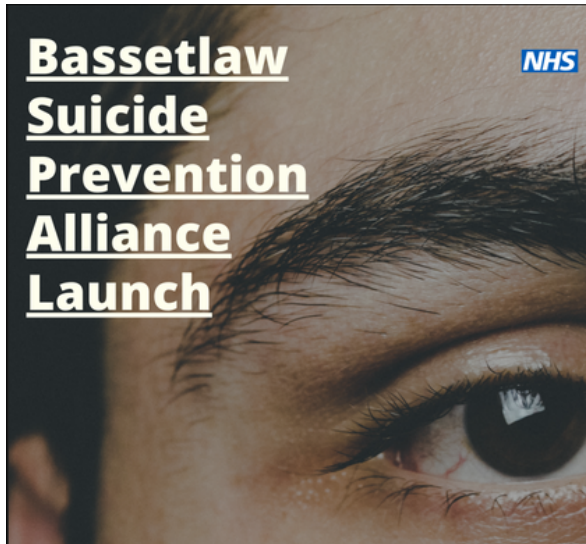

## SUICIDE PREVENTION ALLIANCE LAUNCH

We have recently launched a highly successful Suicide Prevention Alliance in Bassetlaw at The Bridge Skills Hub in Worksop.

This important collaboration across multiple public, community and voluntary sector partners will enable future joint working across the District. The Alliance will mean we can more readily develop a shared commitment and joined up approach to tackling this important issue.

Attendees at the meeting heard heart-rending personal testimony from families and those impacted by suicide. This was at times incredibly moving and powerful. We would especially like to thank local groups such as "In Sam's Name" and "R:pple" and local community leader Vicky Wearing for sharing their personal experiences of suicide.

Place partners will now progress with the development of a Bassetlaw Suicide Prevention Action Plan to take forward the learning and agreed next steps from this event. Targeted lung health checks are coming to Bassetlaw next month in a bid to detect lung cancer early, as well as identify other health conditions such as lung disease. Thousands of people across the district will be invited to take up the invitation to visit a mobile scanner for a lung health check.

We invite all Place partners to actively encourage their work colleagues, families and friends to help spread the word among their contacts and press home the importance of taking up the offer of an appointment to anyone who is offered one.

People aged between 55 and 74 who either smoke or are former smokers, will be invited for an appointment.

The scanner will be at locations in Worksop, Retford and Harworth. The dates will be shared with you and will be posted on our website and on social media as soon as they are confirmed.
