There is 0% Community registered Provision in Oaktree

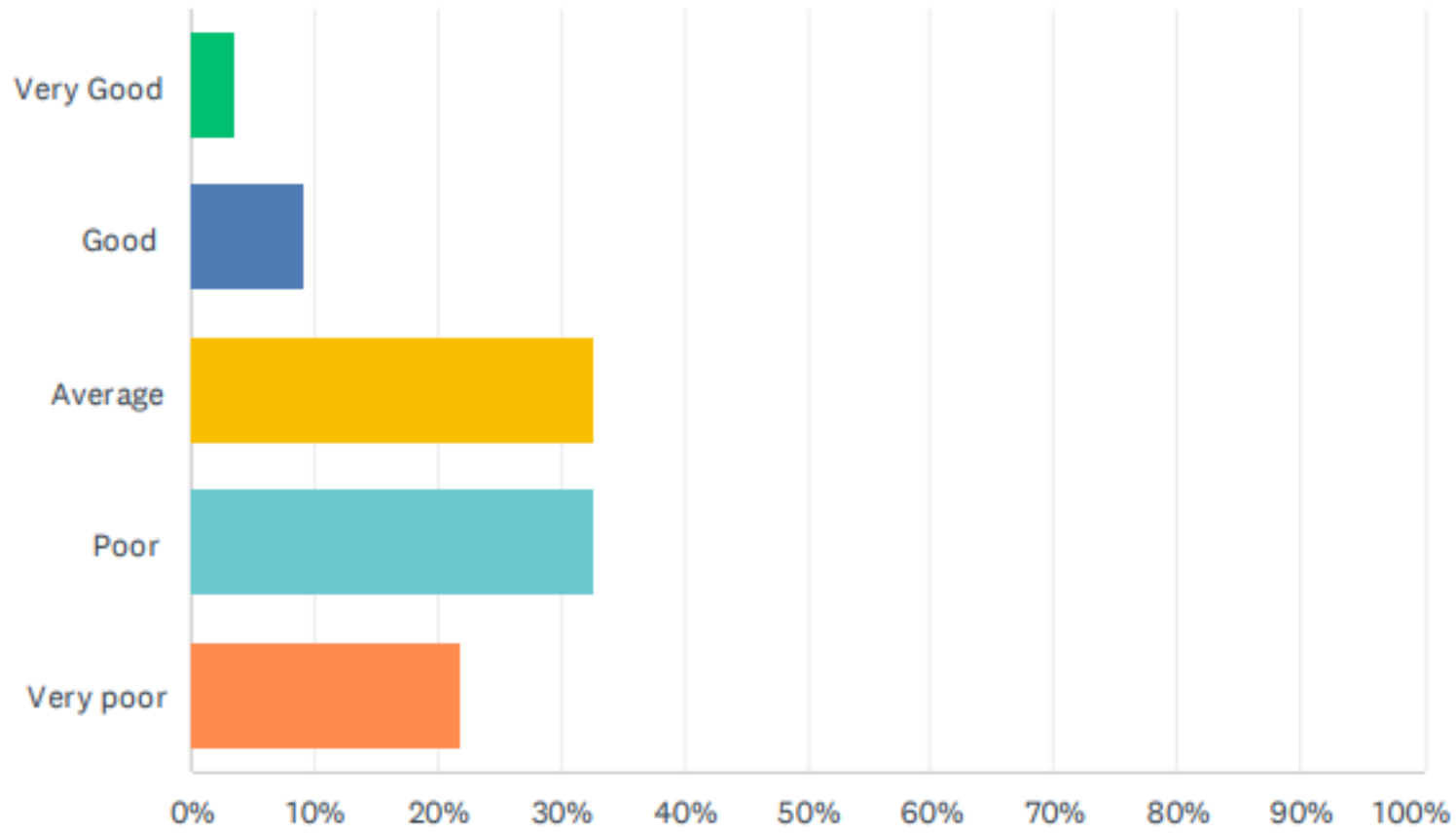

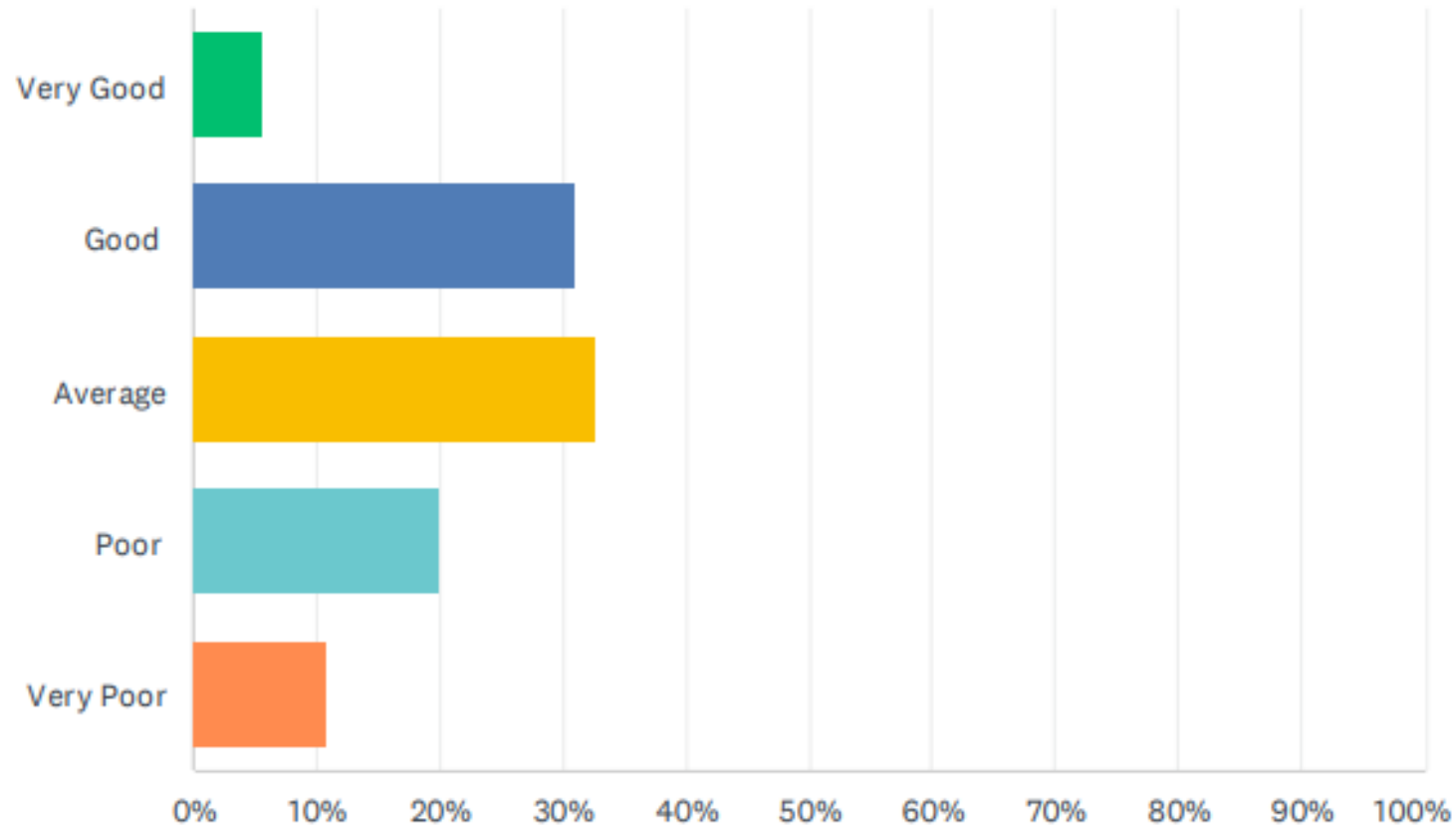
Q1 Would you say access to Health services in Oaktree is:

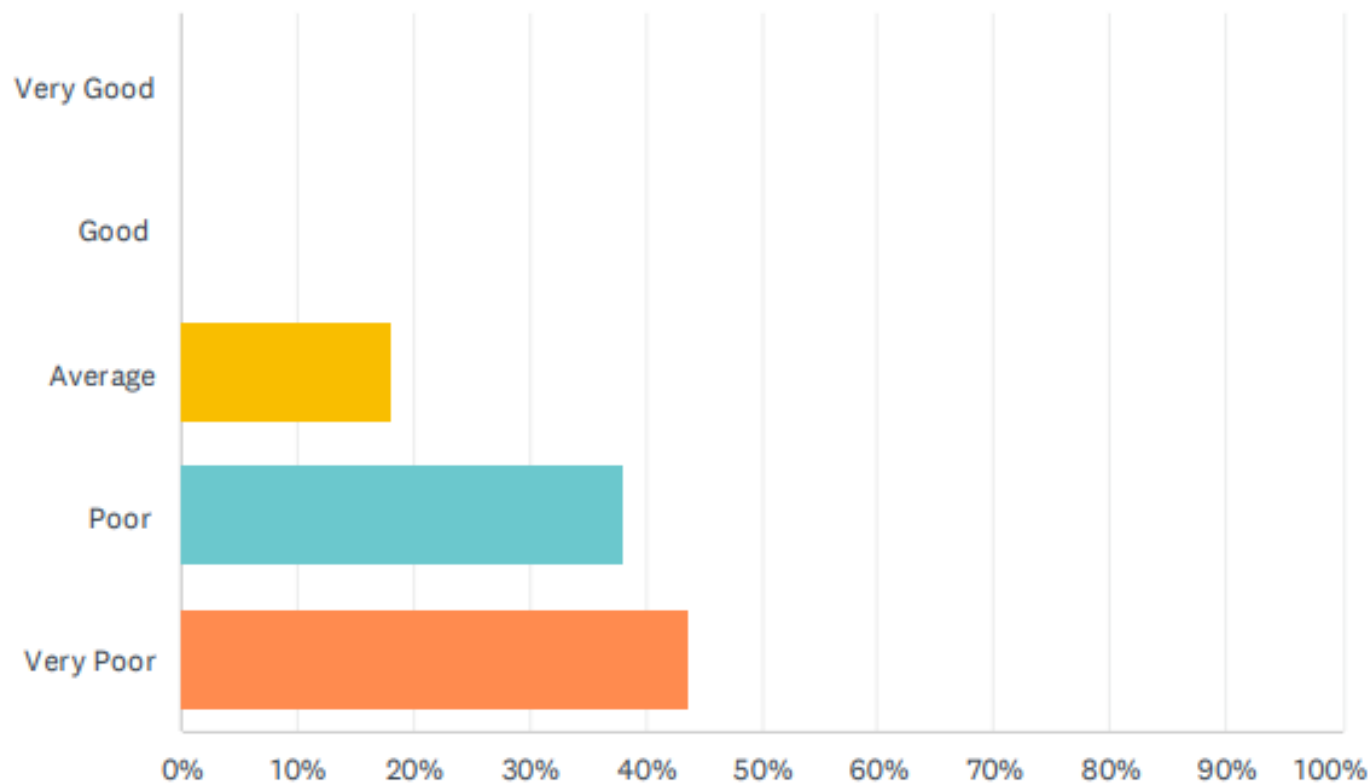
Q2 How would you rate your current health?

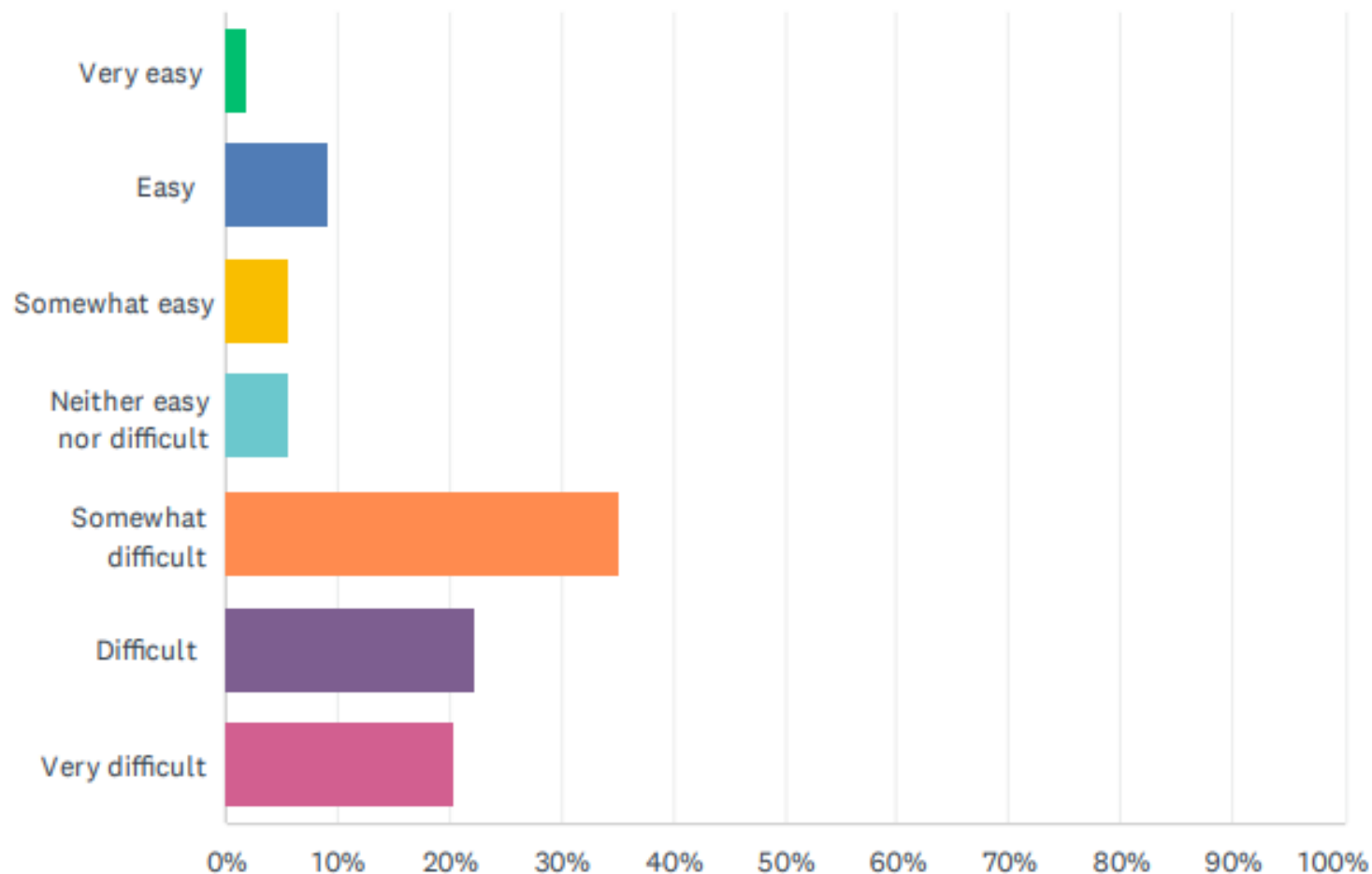
Q3 How would you rate Community services (eg groups) in Oaktree:

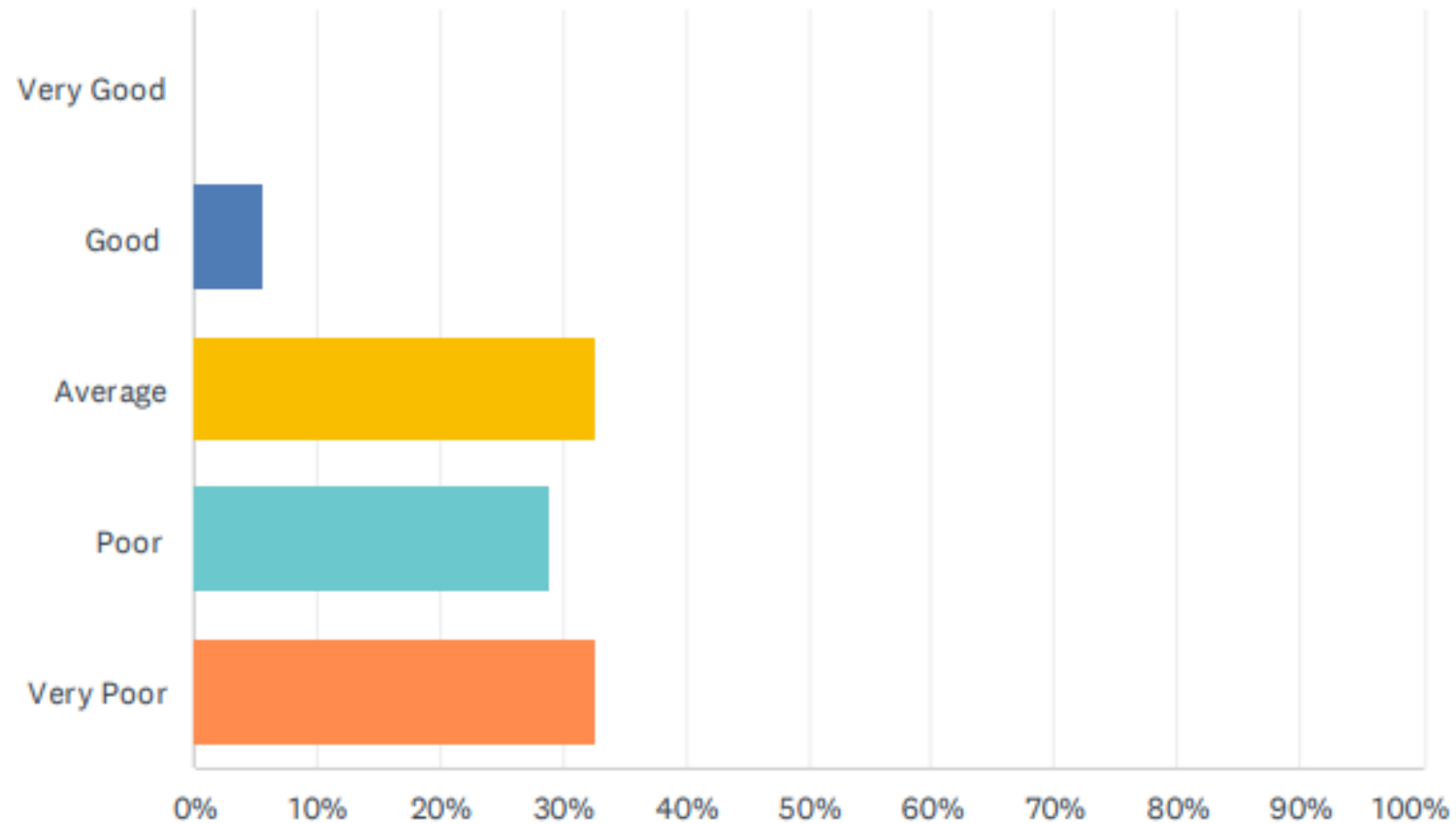
Q4 How easy is it to access your GP?
