Accessing appointments

A PCN website is under development and will be launched in the New Year. The website will be the 'go to' site for information on health promotion and prevention, service interventions, self care, signposting, etc. as well as links to key partners within the PCN.

Meeting the needs of patients is our priority. If you have an urgent medical need, contact your practice at 8am or 2pm Monday to Friday and every effort will be made to offer you a same day appointment. You can book routine appointments online (including via the NHS App). Weekend and evening appointments are also available at designated practices, which can be booked via your practice.
